Please note – An annual Subject Levy of \$25 will apply to all Instrumental Music students. Students who will need to use a school provided instrument will have to pay an additional instrument hire and maintenance fee of \$40 except for percussion players who will pay \$20.

As mentioned in the Prospectus, **Subject Levies** (User Pays) are charged on certain subjects in addition to the joining fees for the Resource Management Scheme. Having these levies enables the School to buy in bulk and pass the savings on to parents.
