As mentioned in the Prospectus for 2009, **Subject Levies** (User Pays) are charged on certain subjects in addition to the joining fees for the Resource Management Scheme. Having these levies enables the School to buy in bulk and pass the savings on to parents.

Invoices for Semester 1 Subject Levies are posted home during Term 4, 2008. Subject Levies for Semester 1 are to be paid by the end of February 2009. If levies are not paid by the end of February for students in Years 9 to 12, a student's enrolment in that subject may be cancelled. Details of all levies are available on request.

A yellow envelope is included (with invoices) for parents to use when forwarding their payment to the School. Please put the completed payment envelope in the collection box located in the Administration Office, during office hours.

Please note - a Subject Levy of \$25 will apply to all Instrumental Music students. Students who will need to use a school provided instrument will have to pay an additional instrument hire and maintenance fee of \$40 except for percussion players who will pay \$20.
